

WEEKLY CHILDREN'S PROGRAM SCHEDULE AT FIRST COLONY BRANCH LIBRARY

Fort Bend County Libraries' First Colony Branch, 2121 Austin Parkway in Sugar Land, presents a variety of free children's programs -- Mother Goose Time, Toddler Time, Story Time, Pajama Night Story Time, and After-School Breaks -- every month. These programs are free and open to the public.

Mother Goose Time, which takes place on Tuesdays at 11:00 am, provides caregiver/infant activities and songs especially designed for the youngest book-lovers, from age 1 month to 12 months. Songs, rhymes, finger plays and simple sign language help stimulate babies' development, through rhythm and music.
